Important Information:



All Elementary and Secondary School students are welcome to play. The only requirement is knowledge of how the chess pieces move.



The competition is designed in such a way that it is easy and enjoyable for first-timers to participate. Everyone gets to play five games regardless of the final results of the games. All participants will be awarded a prize.



The competition will be played in sections according to the grade of Elementary School pupils (grades 1-6). Secondary School pupils (7-9 grades) will play in one group. Preschoolers can participate in the first grade section.



There is a cafeteria at the playing venue where light refreshments and snacks will be available – even edible chess pieces. The lunch break will be from 13:00-14:00, so you will have enough time to go somewhere else to eat as well.



The top three players in each section will receive medals. In addition, there will be a prize draw for a chocolate chess set worth €36.00!

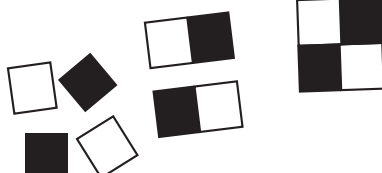
Registration and additional information:
