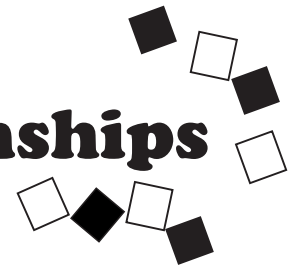




Tampere and District Schools' Chess Championships

General: All Elementary and Secondary School students are welcome to play. The only requirement is knowledge of how the chess pieces move. Each school can be represented by one or more four-player teams in the 1-3 grade and 4-6 grade sections. In the secondary school section schools can be represented by one or more teams of two players. Every team plays 5 games irrespective of the final results. Further information may be obtained from the contact person.

Prizes: The top three teams and best three individual performances on each board in each section will receive medals. In addition all participants will receive participation medals. Two chocolate chess sets worth €29 each will also be included as prizes in a draw in which all competitors are included!

Other: There is a cafeteria at the playing venue where light refreshments and snacks will be available.

Entry Fees and Registration:

Players must register for the competition by **24.5. Note!** Individual players can also enter the competition without a team and we will help to create/find teams for them.

The following information is required for registration to the competition:

- 1) School Name
- 2) Player's name or names (if the whole team line-up is known)
- 3) Player's/players' school grade
